Please take a few minutes to look over the list of possibilities where YOU can volunteer to help lead our membership. We know your time is valuable but we don't require much. Your involvement in the Association will benefit you, and your colleagues.

Please place a check mark next to any committee you may have an interest in, would like to join as a committee member for the 2017-18 school year, or just would like more information on.

- Faculty Council** – meets monthly in your building to discuss building concerns
- Grievance** – meets 4-5 times a year at the EBEA office to discuss possible contract violations and develop solutions
- Educational Support Staff Council** – support staff members will meet 4-5 times a year in the EBEA office to discuss concerns within each of the ESP sub groups. This committee will also plan workshops and social events for our support staff members.
- Elementary School Council** – elementary teachers meet one day per month at the EBEA office to discuss concerns within the elementary level buildings
- Government Relations** – meets a few times during the year at the EBEA office to discuss issues occurring in Public Education. This committee also attends political functions within the county (a few each year)
- Health/Member Benefits** – meets 4-5 times a year at the EBEA office to discuss health benefit changes/options, as well as valuable benefits offered to our members
- Nominations/Elections** – this committee meets 2-3 times per year at the EBEA office in order to facilitate elections within the EBEA
- PRIDE** – meets 3-4 times a year at the EBEA office to plan activities which promote public education within our community
- Public Relations** – this committee will meet 5 times a year in order to gather the “good news” going on in our schools. The committee will write short news stories which will be released to print and online media.

- Representative Council** – meets one Wednesday a month at the EBEA office from 4:00pm to 5:30pm to discuss items important to our members; disseminate this information to members within your building. Nominations/Elections for these positions are held in May.
- Social Affairs** – this committee meets a few times a year to plan and execute social affairs for the members of the EBEA
- Teacher Evaluation Advisory Team** – meets monthly at the EBEA office to discuss trends with the evaluation system; additionally the team will propose workshops to be offered to our members
